

CHALET INFORMATION

BLENHEIM PALACE CHRISTMAS MARKET 2024

All chalets have a hinged shutter that folds up to form an awning. They have insulated roofs and are equipped with a 2Kw heater, an overhead fluorescent light and a 500w domestic power socket for your use. Access is via a separate, lockable door at the back.

Counter Top Chalet

The Counter Top Chalet has a short, fold down flap that forms a forward facing shelf at the bottom of the open window. These chalets are ideal for serving from the window. When the chalet is not in use, the awning folds down to become a shutter and the shelf folds up, all secured from the inside with bolts.



Barn Door Chalet

The Barn Door Chalet has two central doors that can be lifted off their hinges and removed or folded back against the front of the structure allowing people to walk into the chalet. When the chalet is not in use, the doors close and the awning folds down to become a shutter, all secured from the inside with bolts.

Double Chalet

The Double Chalet is made up of two chalets joined together with a weatherproof link to create a single, internal space. The linking section adds about 30 cm to the overall width. Double Chalets can be made from either two Barn Door Chalets or two Counter Top Chalets or a combination of the two.

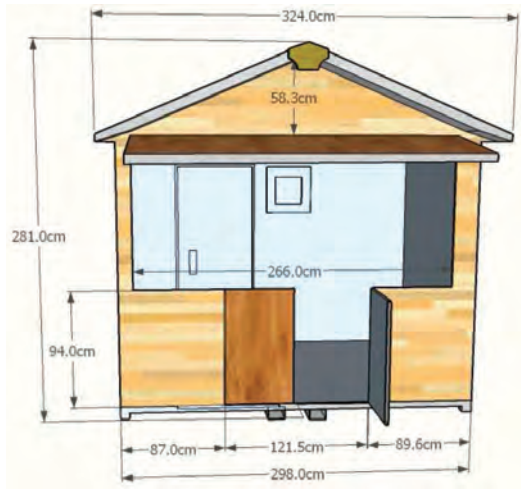


Dual Aspect Chalet

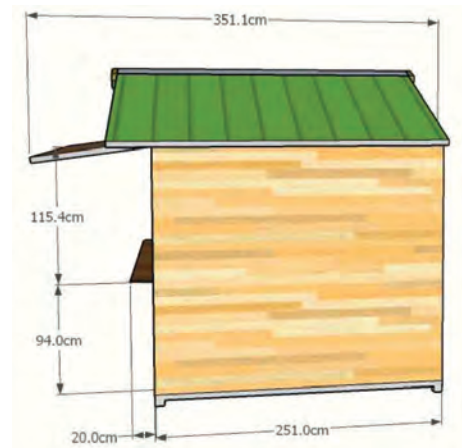
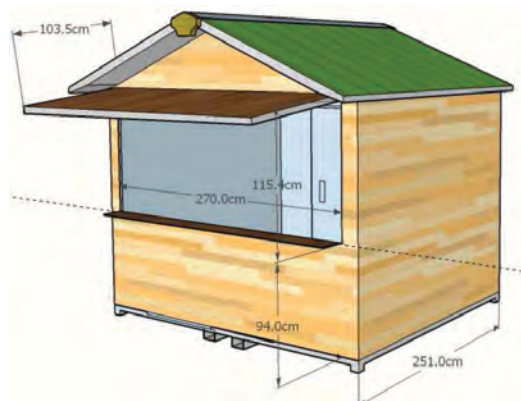
A limited number of single chalets can be fitted with a second opening giving two sides from which to trade. These can be added to either a Counter Top or Barn Door Chalet.

Chalet External Measurements

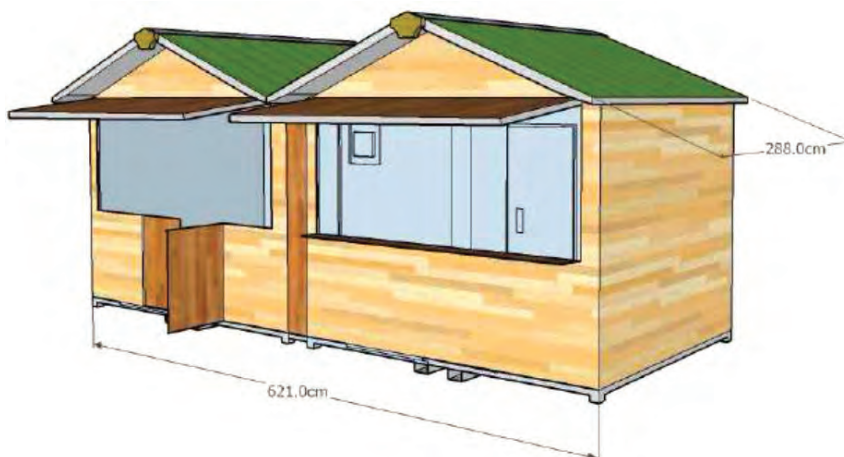
Barn Door Chalet 3.0m x 2.5m

Further Chalet Information

You are allowed to attach shelves and other display equipment to the chalet walls using screws and staples but not using nails. These must not cause damage to the structures and the fixings must be removed at the end of your period. The substantial floor is mounted on a metal frame but fixings to the floor are not allowed. The detailed photographs below may help with your planning and understanding of the chalet structure. The Barn Doors at the front open outwards and fold back on themselves. This gives good access to the chalet and combined with the hinged shutter that folds up, gives good weather protection to the opening. The rear access door also opens outwards and is fitted with a handle and lock. You will be issued with a key on arrival.

Each chalet will be decorated across the front with a garland and festoon lighting. You will also have a personalised trading name plate attached at the front. To maintain a uniform appearance, other than an optional tasteful banner under the shelf of a counter top, no other decorations or adornments are allowed on the outside of the chalet.
